A Rarity in America Judaica

Printed at the Industrial School of the Hebrew Orphan Society. Includes three papers: "Extracts from Jewish Moralists (from the eleventh to the fifteenth century)" by Zunz, "Jewish Marriage in Post-Biblical Times" and "On Interment of the Dead in Post-Biblical Times" by Perles. 8vo in decorative cloth, rear board mottled, 96 pp. + 4 pp. on the officers of the American Jewish Publication Society. Water stained. The texts themselves are not of such vital importance as the publisher and the printers. The AJPS was a failed predecessor to the Jewish Publication Society. The work of the apprentice printers at the Hebrew Orphan Society is of high quality and is a credit to that organization. \$175.00
